The following Deed of Gift from William Townes to John Maibeth being proven before Jesse Carter by the oath of Joseph Benson was presented and Recorded this 21st day of April 1797

State of South Carolina Greenville County, I know all men by these presents that I William Townes of the State and County aforesaid for and in consideration of the love and good will I have towards John Maibeth of the said State and County have given and granted, and by these presents do freely give and grant unto the said John Maibeth his heirs Executors or Administrators a certain negro Girl about twelve years old known by the name of Hannah with all her fixtures Incurance which before the signing of these presents I have delivered him the said John Maibeth to have and to hold the said Negro Girl to him the said John Maibeth his heirs Executors and Administrators from henceforth as his and there right and property without any manner of Condition as witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 10th day of November one thousand seven hundred and ninety six

The following Deed of Conveyance from Martin Purkel to Jesse Kerby being acknowledged before J^r. Alexander Esq^r was presented in open C^t and ordered to be Recorded which was done this 22nd of April 1797

This Indenture made this sixth day of December one thousand seven hundred and ninety three between Martin Purkel of the State of South Carolina and Greenville County of the one part & Jesse Kerby of the said County and State of the other part witnesseth that the said Martin Purkel for and in consideration of the sum of ten pounds lawful Sterling money to him in hand well and Truly paid at and before the sealing & delivery of these presents by the said Jesse Kerby the receipt thereof is hereby fully acknowledged have granted bargained sold aliened and confirmed, and by these presents do grant bargain sell Release and confirm unto him the said Jesse his heirs and assigns for ever all that part of a certain tract of land Originally granted to the said Martin Purkel and signed by his Excellency Charles Pinckney on the fifth day of December one thousand seven hundred and ninety one for ninety acres and lying and being in the said County of Greenville on the north side of River adjoining the said Kerby's line & James Cook's line and the said Martin & Jacob Purkel's lands all that part of the said tract of land beginning on a stone and running S 43. 31 chain to a birch from thence to a corner Stake & thence S 44. 13. 50 to a Gum & thence to a Maple & from thence to a ... & thence with the old line S 44. 00 to a ...
