The following Deed of Conveyance from John Goodwin to Gilbert Sweet being proven before Horatia Griffin Esq. by the oath of John Rodgers was presented and recorded this 4th of June 1797

The State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I John Goodwin of Hencock County and State of Georgia for & in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds Sterling money of the State of S^c Carolina to me paid by Gilbert Sweet of Greenville County and State of South Carolina have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the s^d Gilbert Sweet all that plantation or tract of land containing three hundred & thirteen acres be the same more or less situated lying and being in the County of Greenville State of South Carolina on Rudy river a branch of Saluda River beginning on an old oak corner of running N 95 E 56 ch or to a post oak corner of running thence N 56 56 ch or to a stake corner of thence N 35 W 56 ch or to a stake corner of thence S 55 W 56 ch or to the beginning the same being Originally granted unto David Head Coons on the sixteenth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Eighty four and in the ninth year of the Independance of the United States of America reference being thereunto had will more fully and at large appear Together with all the singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said Gilbert Sweet his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & Administrators to warrant & for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Gilbert Sweet his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
