

The following Deed of Conveyance from John Baldwin to Samuel Pegg being proven before John McChoy Esq. by the oath of Hizekiah Cokerham was presented and recorded this 12th day of June A.D. 1797

This Indenture made this second day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven between John Baldwin of the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville of the one part, and Samuel Pegg of the State and County aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the said John Baldwin for and in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds Sterling Money to him in hand paid by the said Samuel Pegg at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said John Baldwin doth hereby acknowledge hath bargain- ed sold and delivered, aliened released and confirmed unto the said Samuel Pegg his heirs and assigns for ever a certain plantation or tract of land con- taining three hundred acres (more or less) lying in the aforesaid County being part of a tract of eight hundred & Sixty acres Originally sur- veyed of John Pyle by Jonathan Downes on the tenth day of December 1787 under a grant from under the hand of Thomas Pinckney Esq. Go- vernor and commander of the said State recorded in Grant Book 4 U.S. page 191 being laid out unto the said Samuel Pegg as follows beginning at a Chesnut Corner running thence S 30 E 77-25 to a pine corner, thence S 75 W 55 to a post oak, thence N 20 W 79 to a post oak, thence on a direct line to the beginning lying on the head of Bakers Creek to have and to hold the said Tract of three hundred acres more or less together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto in any wise belonging to the said Samuel Pegg his heirs and assigns for ever, and the said John Baldwin doth hereby warrant and defend him the said Samuel Pegg in the peaceable and uninterrupted possession thereof from the lawful claim of every other person or persons whatsoever for ever or his heirs or assigns In witness whereof the said John Baldwin doth hereunto set his hand and seal the day and date first above written
