

The following Deed of Conveyance from Moses Clayton to Francis Clayton being proven before John Blackwell Esq. by the oath of William Clayton was presented and Recorded this 16<sup>th</sup> June 1797  
 This Indenter made the first day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety six between Moses Clayton of Madison County State of Kentucky of the one part & Francis Clayton of Beaufort County State of South Carolina of the other part witnesseth that the said Moses Clayton for and in consideration sum of Eight pounds Sterling Money to him in hand paid by the said Francis Clayton the receipt whereof the said Moses Clayton doth hereby acknowledge himself fully satisfied and paid, and by these presents hath given granted bargained and sold and conveyed unto him the said Francis Clayton part of certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Greensville State of our<sup>s</sup> containing one hundred acres be the same more or less it being part of a Tract of five hundred & twenty four acres granted to William Clayton by his Excellency William Moultrie the grant bearing date one thousand seven hundred and ninety three by him conveyed to S. Tonston, and from Tonston to said Moses Clayton from Moses Clayton to Francis Clayton bounded as followeth beginning at a white oak at an agreed corner thence along white line to his corner and from thence to the top of Maxwells Ridge, thence along the S. Ridge to the hog back Moultrie, thence all the land to the South of S. Ridge within the Original plat containing one hundred acres be the same more or less together with all and singular the rights and and priviledges therunto belonging in any wise appertaining to the <sup>above</sup> said land and premises and S. Moses Clayton doth Covenant and agree to and with said Francis Clayton that he the said Francis Clayton shall and may for ever hereafter peaceable and quietly have hold and enjoy the <sup>above</sup> said land and premises without Molestation of any person or persons whatsoever and the S. Moses Clayton his Executors or Administrators to him the said Francis Clayton his heirs or assigns do promise to warrant and for ever defend the title of the aforementioned land & premises in witness whereof he hath set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year first above written
