 I Thomas Beale of Fincastle in the County of Botetourt State of Virginia
 Merchant by the power in me vested by Alexander Pitt Buckhannon
 by a power of attorney bearing date the second day of February in the
 year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven author-
 izing me the said Thomas Beale to dispose of, and convey the fee
 simple of certain tracts of land therein mentioned to any purchaser
 or purchasers, under the restrictions contained in the said power
 of attorney) in consideration of six hundred and twenty five
 dollars to me paid by Lemuel James Alston of the State of South
 Carolina and County of Greenville planter have granted bargained
 sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell
 and release unto the said Lemuel J. Alston all that plantation
 or tract of land containing four hundred acres situate lying &
 being in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville on
 the Branches of Reedy River, the same being originally granted
 to Jacob O'Bannon etc by a grant bearing date the 21st day of
