 mises unto the said William Stroud his heirs and assigns for ever to enjoy
 peaceable and quiet possession the same land and premises with all and every part
 thereof from the S. John Justice his heirs administrators and assigns for ever
 and he the S. William Stroud his heirs Executors Administrators & assigns
 to hold the S. land and premises free from all person or persons whatsoever
 laying any lawful right title claim or demand whatsoeuer thereto in
 witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal December
 th 11 and in the year of our Lord God one thousand seven hundred thirty six

The following deed of Conveyance from Richard Hooper to Woody Cant-
 well being proven before John Blackwill Esq^r by the oath of Langston
 McKay was presented and recorded this 14th September 1797

This Indenture made this Twentieth day of January one thousand seven
 hundred and ninety seven between Richard Hooper of the State of Carolina
 and County of Pendleton of the one part and Woody Cantwell of the State
 afores^d and County of Greenville of the other part witnesseth that the S. Richard
 Hooper for the consideration of the sum of twelve pounds paid by the said
 Woody Cantwell the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and the S. Richard
 Hooper have granted bargained and sold unto the S. Woody Cantwell a
 certain Tract or parcel of land containing fifty acres of land more or less
 beginning on a post oak running a conditional line to John Cantwell S^r.
 Spring branch, down the said branch to Armstrongs Creek down S. Creek
 to enable thence the S. Hoopers original line to and oak corner, thence
 to the beginning, and I the S. Richard Hooper do warrant and for ever de-
 fend the above mentioned Tract of land clear from from the claim of
 any person to the S. Woody Cantwell in witness whereof I have hereunto
 set my hand and seal the day and date above mentioned
