Ebroy Esq. by the oath of James Ashmore was presented and Recorded this 29th December 1797 State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that I Frederick Croft Senr. of Greenville County and State aforesaid for and in consideration of fifty pounds lawful current money to me paid by George Croft of the said County and State aforesaid have granted, bargained sold, and released, and by these presents do Grant bargain sell and release unto the said George Croft all that Tract or parcel of land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Greenville and on the Needy fork of Needy River whereon the said George Croft now lives, containing by estimation two hundred acres more or less bounded on the South by Hans Blacks lands South Easterly by Henry Prasuns land Northwardly by land Surveied ^{for} Johnston, Westwardly by Hezekiah Lockrams land, Together with all and Singular the rights members hereditaments, and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any way Incident or appertaining to have and to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said George Croft his heirs and assigns for ever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and for ever defend all & singular the said premises unto the said George Croft his heirs & assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same in any part thereof witness my hand & Seal this Twenty seventh day of Decemr. one thousand seven hundred Ninety seven and of the Independence of America the twenty second
