The following deed of Conveyance from George Wilson to Josiah Fowler  
 being proven before James Ridgore Esq. by the oath of William Collins was  
 presented and Recorded this 23<sup>rd</sup> January 1798

This Indenture made this third day of January in the year of our Lord  
 God one thousand seven hundred and ninety six between George Wilson  
 of the State of South Carolina and County of Pickensville of the one part  
 and Josiah Fowler of the same State and County of Greenville of the other  
 part witnesseth that the said George Wilson for and in consideration of  
 of the sum of forty pounds to him in hand paid good and lawful mon-  
 ey of the s<sup>t</sup>. State by him the said Josiah Fowler the receipt whereof is  
 hereby acknowledged that he the said George Wilson hath bargained  
 sold remised released and conveyed and by these presents doth grant  
 bargain sell, remise release convey and confirm unto the said Josiah  
 Fowler his heirs Executors Administrators or assigns a Tract of land lying  
 and being on the waters of Enoree River Called Durbens Creek in the  
 aforesaid State and County of Greenville Containing one hundred and  
 eleven acres running N. on S. Richard Fowlers old line & S. W. on John  
 Younks old line and all other sides on vacant land, the same being  
 granted unto Richard Fowler by his Excellency William Bull Esq. Gov-  
 nor the twenty sixth of July in the year one thousand seven hundred  
 and seventy four, and from the said Richard Fowler to George Wilson  
 by conveyance as doth appear by a plat and the line agreed upon  
 between the s<sup>r</sup>. Richard Fowler and George Wilson and from s<sup>r</sup>. Richard  
 Fowler to George Wilson and this Indenture witnesseth that he the  
 said George Wilson hath for an in consideration of the sum of  
 forty pounds Sterg. Money to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is  
 hereby acknowledged hath bargained and sold the said one hundred  
 and eleven acres of land Together with all and singular the appurtenances  
 thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining as also the reversion &  
 reversions rents profits and Issues and every part and parcel thereof unto  
 the only proper and absolute use and behoof of him the said Josiah Fowler
