This indenture made this third day of October one thousand seven
 hundred and ninety six Between James R. of Granville County
 and State of South Carolina of the one part and George Washington Currier
 of the County and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the
 said James R. doth for and in consideration of the sum of Ten shilling
 Lawful Sterling money to him in hand well and truly Paid by the said
 George Washington Currier at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents
 the Receipt whereof is here by fully acknowledged by the said James
 R. doth grant Bargain Sell and confirm and
 By these presents doth grant Bargain Sell and confirm unto
 the said George Washington Currier, him, his heirs and assigns forever all that
 certain tract of Land Originally granted unto John Rapperty and
 signed by Governor Pinckney on the 17 Day of October one thousand seven
 hundred and eighty eight lying and being in the County
 of Granville and on the waters of Sandy River hereunto well
 fully appurtenant to the said George Washington Currier as follows to
 Beginning on the north side a branch called Quirt branch and running
 on one persons line to Stake
