date the twenty first of January one thousand seven hundred & Eighty five
Beginning at a Post oak corner running thence N 25° 30' W 80 links to a
Post oak thence S 60° W 110 links to a stake thence to the Beginning
thence containing two hundred acres more or less together with all and singular the
Rights members & Appurtenances to the said premises
Belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have to have & to hold all
