

511 The following deed of conveyance from Isaac Perkins to Rubin Cooplin being
proven before Oratia Griffith by the oath of William Curl was presented and
Recorded this 29th Day of March 1798.

State of South Carolina This Indenture made the 5th day of July one thousand
Seven hundred and ninety Eight between Isaac Perkins of Greenwell County and State
of the one part and Rubin Cooplin of County and State aforesaid
of the other part witnesseth that the said Isaac Perkins for and in consideration
of the sum of Eighty pounds Sterling money to me in hand paid the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledge hath granted Bargained sold and delivered and by this
presents doth grant Bargain sell all full Conveyance and Confirmation unto the said
Rubin Cooplin and his heirs forever three hundred acres more or less of Land
it being part of a tract of Land originally granted unto the said Perkins by his
Excellencie Armandus Banderhoest bearing date the first day of December 1794
and Recorded in Grant Book O No 4 Page 296 Beginning at a Stake on the
old line thence along the dividing ^{line} to the old line thence to Stake corner then
E 30 to a post oak X thence N 37 to a post oak corner N 21 50 thence to a
pine corner N 25 to post oak S 50 W 54 50 thence to a post oak corner
S 20 to a Stake E 4: 50: S 70: to the beginning supposed to contain
three hundred acres more or less together with all and singular the ^{houses}
Improvements waters ways and hereditaments and other lawfull
things therunto Belonging or in any wise appertaining thereunto
to have and to hold the above tract or parcel of Land containing
three hundred acres more or less with all ^{the} appurtenances from
me and my heirs forever unto the said Isaac Perkins doth warrant
and for ever defend the said premises from all and Every Lawfull
Claim that shall arise ~~from~~ for the same unto the said Rubin
Cooplin and his heirs forever as witnesseth whereof I have set my
hand and affixed my seal the day and date aforesaid written

being proven before James Hilgore Esq. by the oath Samuel Howard
was presented and Recorded this 30th of March 1798

John Still of the State of South Carolina Greenwell County of the
one part and Edward Howard of the State of County aforesaid
of the other part witnesseth that the said John Still
