

Witnesseth that the said James West doth for and in consideration of the sum of thirty pounds Lawfull sterling money in hand paid by the said John Moors at and before the Sealing & delivering of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby fully acknowledged by the said James West doth Grant Bargain sell alien Release and confirm unto the said John Moors him his heirs and assigns forever all that part of a certain tract of Land Originally granted to the said James West for six hundred and forty acres lying & being in the County of Granville and on the Breedy Fork of Steady River and signed by James Moultrie Mouttree on the 6th Day of November 1786 Reference thereunto will fully appear. all that part of the said Tract of Land Excepting Two acres given by the parties for the use of the Methodist commonly known by the name of F. Coopers Meeting house to be layd out in asquar Including said meeting house in the Centre thereof Beginning on a Post oak the Original corner from thence on the Original line ^{line} N. 65^o thirty two Chain & crossing a Creek to a Stake corner from thence S. E. 25^o along a line of marked trees thirty two Chain to a Stake corner thence S. W. 65^o along a line of marked trees thirty two Chain to a Stake corner on the original line thence ^{line} N. 65^o on the original line to the beginning containing one hundred and two acres to the same more or less and being now in actual possession of him the said Moors Together with all and singular the trees wasps waters hereditaments rights members and appurtenances what soever unto the said tract of Land belonging or in any wise appertaining and the reversions and Reversions Remainders & Remainders Rents Issues & profits thereof to have and to hold the aforesaid Parcel or Tract of Land and premises as above described with their and every of their appurtenances unto the said John Moors him his heirs & assigns to his and their only proper use and behoof Absolutely & forever and lastly the said James West doth Covenant & agree to & with the said John Moors that the above described tract of Land unto the said John Moors him his heirs and assigns against the legal claim of any person or persons what so ever shall and will warrant and forever defend as witness there to the said James West doth here unto set his hand & Seal this day and year first above written.
