

Know all men by these presents that I Elias Earle of the said County in the State aforesaid in consideration of six hundred Dollars in hand already paid by Robert Cook of the said County the Receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and Release unto the said Robert Cooke all that Valuable tract or Parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Greenville and District of Hacking to on the West Side of the North fork of Saluda River Beginning on a stone opposite a dogwood Station thence North 82 East 17 Chains 50 links to a post oak corner then S. 8 E East 44 1/2 chains 8 1/2 link to a black corner then N. 82 W East 17 1/2 to the river thence up the several meanders of the said river to the beginning in which said boundaries and courses containing three hundred acres be the same more or less together with all and Singular the Right members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging in any wise incident or appertaining thereto and to hold all and Singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said Robert Cooke his heirs and assigns forever And I do here by bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and defend all and Singular the said premises unto the said Robert Cooke his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and againsts every person whosoever lawfully claiming in this County the same or any part thereof will neff my hands and Seal this <sup>Eighth</sup> day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred and ninety eight and in the twenty second year of the Independence of the United States of America Elias Earle *D*
