 warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the weal
 his heirs & assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other
 person or persons who hereafter lawfully claiming or to claim the same
 or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this 6th day of December
 in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven
 and in the twenty first year of the Independence of the United States
 of America signed sealed and delivered in the presence of

The following deed of conveyance from John Mottow to Richard Steegall
 being proven before Robert Cook Esq^r by the oath of John Peace
 & Joseph Mottow they was presented and recorded this 10th day of April 1798
 State of South Carolina } Know all men by these presents that I John
 Greenville County } Mottow of the State and County aforesaid in
 consideration of one negro woman named Easter and one negro boy named
 Adam one wagon and sund gear and one hundred Dollars cash to me
 paid by Richard Steegall of the County aforesaid have granted sold
 conveyed and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell
 and release unto the said Richard Steegall all that tract or parcel
 of Land lying and being in Greenville County Washington District
 on the N^o side of Saluda river including the mouth of Checkaroe
 River containing two hundred Acres granted unto Alexander Mc
 Henry bearing date July the sixteenth in the year of our Lord one
 thousand seven hundred and Eighty four and in the ninth year
 of the independence of the United States of America under
 the name of his Excellency Benjamin Guerard Esq^r Governor
 and Commander in chief in and over the said State having the great
 Seal of said State thereunto affixed having such forms and marks
 as appears by a plat to the said grant annexed being duly Recorded
