This Indenture made the fourth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven Between Meredith Blackburn of the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville of the one part and Jacob Cooley senior of said State and County of the other Witnesseth that said Meredith for and in Consideration of the sum of sixty pounds Sterling money to him in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and Delivering

of these presents the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto said Jacob his heirs and assigns forever all that plantation or tract of Land containing one hundred and ten acres more or less surveyed by Lewis on the fourth day of April 1783 situate in the County aforesaid on the north side of Saluda River beginning on a Sicory corner on said River running thence N.E. 68.31. 62 to a post oak station pursuing said course to a post oak corner thence S.E. 22. 36. 00 to a pine station pursuing the same course to a stake corner thence S.W. 67. 32. 62 to a corner on said river surrounded on all sides at the time of survey by vacant Land Recorded in Secretarys office Book 133 page 469 to have and to said tract of Land containing as aforesaid together with all the appurtenances of any kind what soever thereunto in any wise belonging unto said Jacob Cooley heirs and assigns and any person what soever claiming under him here by warranting and defending the said Cooley his heirs and assigns forever in their peaceable enjoyment of the same against the claim Right title or demand of any person or persons what soever In witness whereof Thereunto set my hand and Seal the day and year first above written signed sealed & delivered in presents of J.
