This Indenture made this 14<sup>th</sup> Day of April in the year of our Lord  
one thousand seven hundred and Ninety Eight in the twenty first year of  
Americas Independancy Between John Standford of the one party of Greenville  
State of South Carolina of the one part & Thomas Nichols of the other  
part of the County and State aforesaid Witnesseth that the s<sup>d</sup> John  
Standford being for & in the consideration of the sum of Fifty pounds  
lawful Money to him in hand paid by the s<sup>d</sup> Thomas Nichols the  
right where of is hereby acknowledged & the s<sup>d</sup> John Standford is

Presents do grant Bargain and sell alien in the Enfeoff & Confirm unto the  
s<sup>d</sup> Thomas Nichols all that Messuage Tract or parcel of Land lying Situate  
in the s<sup>d</sup> County of Greenville is now in his possession now being a Part of  
Two hundred acres (the same being more or less) the southward Division  
of a tract of four hundred & Ninety acres of Land Granted to John Portman  
by a grant under the hand of his Excellency William Moutrie Esq<sup>r</sup>  
Governor and Commander in Chief in & over the State of South Carolina
