The following Deed of Conveyance from William Morgan to James Taylor being proven before Robert McLauchlin ^{Esq;} by the oath of Ephraim Clledge was presented and Recorded this 28th Day of June 1798

This Indenture made this Second day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety seven between William Morgan of the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville of the one part & James Taylor of the same place of the other part witnesseth that the ^sr William Morgan for & in consideration of the sum of twenty five pounds Sterling money to him in hand paid by the ^sr James Taylor the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged to the ^sr William Morgan hath bargained & sold & by these presents doth bargain & sell unto the ^sr James Taylor a certain tract or parcel of Land containing by estimation Eighty acres lying & being in Greenville County on both sides of Mountain Creek of Moore River it being part of a tract of land originally granted to Isaac Gray beginning on a post oak between the old School house & James Taylors and running on Russells line to Mountain Creek to a branch thence up the branch to the mouth of a branch that mouths on ^{the} North side the creek at a meadow to a black gum tree running a straight line across the ridge on ^{the} North side the Creek to the Creek again thence down the back to the south of the School house branch on Simons line to a black oak Simons corner from thence a straight line to the beginning which ^sr tract of land of Eighty acres be of same more or less with all and belonging to its appurtenances the ^sr William Morgan doth from himself & his heirs & from all & every other person & persons will warrant & forever defend to the ^sr James Taylor his heirs & assigns for ever in witness whereof the ^sr William Morgan hath hereunto set his hand & seal the day & year above written signed sealed & delivered in presence of Ephraim Clledge ^{his} witness

State of South Carolina I know all men by these presents that I George Graham of Greenville County and State aforesaid for and consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty Dollars to me in hand Paid by Solomon Loftis of Greenville County and State aforesaid have granted Bargained sold Released and Conveyed and by these Presents do grant bargain sell and Release unto the said Solomon Loftis a plantation or tract of land lying and being in Greenville County and state aforesaid on the Beaver Dam Creek of Big River being part of tract of land granted to Frances Dodds and by William Dodds late Executor of Frances Dodds Conveyed by a Deed or Lease to the said Graham on the twenty eighth day of October in the year one thousand seven hundred and Ninety seven beginning on a channel running N^o 3 & E^o 2 to a Hickory corner made when Abram Randolphs Land was taken of a part of this tract thence a long Randolps line to a maple corner thence along Stephen Dills line as its courses to the old line at a Sowerwood corner made when Dills part was laid off there to the beginning corner containing all the tract of three hundred twenty three acres except the two tracts of land laid off one to Dill the other to Randolph supposed to be one hundred and nine acres the same more or less to gather with all and singularly the wrote members and hereditaments and appurtenances as to the said premises belonging or in any wise pertaining to him and to hold all and singularly the premises before mentioned unto the ^sr Solomon Loftis his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my Heirs Executors Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singularly the said premises unto the said Solomon Loftis his heirs and assigns Agt myself my Heirs and agt all and every other Person lawfully claiming unto claim the same or any part thereof In witness whereof I the George Graham have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this twenty eighth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven in the twenty second year of Americans Asaph Evans signing Seal, and Delivered in presence of the witnesses Mary Fugsmith, Solomon Loftis, Charles Loftis
