This Indenture made this twenty 6<sup>th</sup> day of January in the year of our  
Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety seven and in two years  
year of a meane American Independence between Auguston Clayton of the State  
of South Carolina Spartanburgh County of the one part and Robert  
Sutton of the same State aforesaid and County of Greenville of the other part  
Witnesseth the said Auguston Clayton for and in consideration of to the  
sum of One hundred Pounds to him in hand paid by the said Robert Sutton the Receipt  
whereof is hereby acknowledged and his the said Auguston Clayton fully  
taketh receipt therewith and he hath given granted Bargained sold and  
Conformed unto the said Robert Sutton a small parcel or tract of land  
Supposed to be two hundred acres more or less being a parcel of eight  
hundred and seventy two acres of land granted unto the said Auguston  
Clayton by a grant bearing date the first day of July one thousand  
seven hundred and Nine ty two and is bound as follows and
