being proven before Reuben Barrett Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oaths of Alexander  
McDonald was presented and Recorded the 2<sup>nd</sup> Day of July 1778

This Indenture made the eighteenth day of January in the year  
our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety three and in the  
sixteenth year of our American Independence between John Clay-  
ton of the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina Planter  
of the one part and John Bush of the County and State aforesaid  
Planter of the other part witnesseth that the said John Clayton  
for and in consideration of the sum of sixty Pounds lawful money to  
him in hand well and truly paid by the said John Bush the Receipt  
whereof is hereby acknowledged and the said John Clayton fully  
satisfyed he the said John Clayton have granted Bargained and sold  
and by these Presents do grant bargain and sell all his Lyes off and  
confirm unto the said John Bush all that Misueage tract or  
parcel of Land situate in the said County of Greenville On San her  
burys beaver dam a branch of the middle fork of Lygar River being  
part of tract of land granted to the said John Clayton by deed from Will-  
iam Swift granted to the said William Swift by a grant bearing  
date the 1<sup>st</sup> Day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand  
hundred and forty six under the hand of his Excellency William  
Moultrie and the seal of the said State being duly recorded in the  
Secretarys office of said State Reference thereto had well more  
fully appear beginning at a tree on or near swifts uppe-

running thence a border line fine to a black oak thence to a red oak in  
the creek thence cross the creek to a red oak thence to the head of a branch  
inclosing the spring thence to a red oak thence abstract course to south  
line thence west as and said line to the corner tree from thence along so

presented and Recorded this 2<sup>nd</sup> Day of July 1778

This Indenture Made the fifth Day of February in the year of our Lord one  
thousand seven hundred and ninety three and in the sixteenth year of  
our American Independence between James Vernon of the County  
of Spartanburg and State of South Carolina Planter of the one part  
and John Bush of the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina  
of the other part witnesseth that the said James Vernon for and in considera-  
tion of the sum of fifty pounds lawful money to him in hand well  
and truly paid by the said John Bush the Receipt whereof is hereby ac-  
knowledged and the said James Vernon fully satisfied he the said James  
Vernon have granted Bargained and sold and by these presents do  
grant Bargain and sell all his Lyes off and confirm unto the said John
