This Indenture made this Twentieth Day of January in the year of our Lord one
Thousand seven hundred and Ninety four and in the eighteenth year of
American Independence between John Pyle of the State of South Carolina
and Greenville County of the one part & Benjamin Pollard of the said State
and County of the other part Witnesseth that the said John Pyle for and
in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds Sterling paid by the
said Benjamin Pollard and before the calling and Delivery of
these presents the Receipt whereof the said John Pyle doth hereby acknowledge
and of and from every part and parcel thereof do acquit and Discharge the
Benjamin Pollard his heirs and assigns Do grant bargain sell alien and con-
firm and the said Benjamin Pollard his heirs and assigns forever three hun-
dred Acres of Land (more or less) situated in Greenville County on a branch of
the Needy Fork of Needy River called Pyles branch being part of
a tract of Land originally granted to the said John Pyle and signed by his
Cousin William Moutrie on the fourth Day of September in the year of
our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Eighty six only a part of the
said grant will more fully appear said out to the said Benjamin Pollard as follows
Beginning on the original line at William Lees corner and running S 60 E. to a
Stake Thence Running S 70 E. 25 to a Pine thence Running S 110 W. 59 to
a pine thence Running S 65 W. 91 25 to a Post oak and from thence Running
Through the said Land an William Lees line to the beginning including includ-
ing three hundred acres (more or less) together with all and singular the
houses out houses ways waters paths Passages trespasses easements Servi-
tutements and appertinances whatsoever to the said tract of Land so descri-
bed as above belonging or in any wise appertaining and the Reversions
and Reversions Remainders and Remainders Rents Issues and profits
thereof and every part and parcel thereof and all the Estate Right Title Interest
Claim and Demand whatsoever both in Law & Equity of the said John Pyle
of in and to the same premises and of in and to every part and parcel
thereof to have and to hold the said parcel or tract of three hundred acres
of Land more or less all and singular other the premises above men-
tioned with the appertinances unto the said Benjamin Pollard his
heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Benjamin
Pollard his heirs and assigns forever. And lastly the said John Pyle for him-
self his heirs Executors and Administrators the said parcel or tract of three
hundred acres of Land more or less with the premises and appertinances
thereunto belonging unto the said Benjamin Pollard his heirs & assigns

for and in consideration of Twelve pounds Sterling to me in hand paid by
Matthew Yame Junr one Black & white Cow & half the Cow about
Ten years old Marked with the crop in the right ear & half crop in the left ear
also one Two year old heifer Red & white with some white in the face also one year
old Red & white heifer Yearling both of the same Mark of the Cow above
mentioned also three Barrows & one Sow to wit a black one Little a black one
a white List round it & the other Barrow above Red Sandy with white List round
them about Eighteen Months old Marked with a crop in the left ear & half
crop in the right also one Bed and furniture also one six gallon Pot & a
small oven and a small Pot & Paels & one pair of Pot hooks and one large Bell
and collar and also 2 Butter Dishes & small Basins & Six Plates & Six Spoons
and one Coping as Together with sundry other small Articles For Testimony to
mention Witness my hand this Eleventh Day of July in the year 1798

sell and Release unto the said Moses Crafford all that Plantation
or tract of Land containing one hundred and ten acres of Land be the
same More or less situate in Greenville County lying on a branch
of horse Creek waters of Needy River Beginning on a white Oak 31st 30th
