 Know all men by these Presents that James Chestain of the State of N. Carolina Bunham County for and in Consideration of the sum of two hundred Dollars well and truly paid before the Delivering of these Presents to me R. Richard Russell and by these presents have Bargained Sold Released and conveyed and By these Presents do grant Bargain Sell Release convey and confirm unto Richard Russell of S. Carolina Greenville County all that tract or Parcel of Land lying and being in Greenville County and State aforesaid on the waters of South tiger River adjoining Henry Primes Land Beginning on a Red oak N. 30 W. 48. 30 to a Black oak N. 60 E. to a small Hickory thence N. 10. W. to a Red oak thence S. 46 W. 31. 20. to a post oak thence S. 46. 20. to a Stake thence N. 75 E. 38. 40 to the Beginning Corner Containing one hundred & thirty five Acres more or less granted unto the said James Chestain by his Excellency William Moultrie on the first day of January in the year one thousand Seven hundred and eighty Seven having in such shapes forms marks Butting and Boundery as appears by the plat to the said Grant annexed together with all woods water courses orchards garden houses fences and all the improvements there on to have and to hold all the said bargained premises unto the said Richard Russell his heirs and assigns forever to

The following deed of Conveyance from Batte Birdsong to John Jones being proven before James Kilgore Esq. by the oath of Ephram Rees was presented and Recorded this 18th day of September 1798
 This Indenture made this 6th day of April and in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety six and of Sovereignty and Independence of the united States of North America the twentieth day of February Batte Birdsong of the one part and John Jones of the other Part of the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina Witnesseth that for and in the Consideration of the sum of sixty four Pounds Sterling money in hand paid to the said Birdsong by the said John Jones at or before the sealing and delivering of this presents the Receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge and there fore doth acquit and discharge the said Jones his heirs and assigns by these presents And the said Batte Birdsong doth by these presents Bargain sell Grant alien and confirm unto the said John Jones his heirs and assigns a certain Parcel of Land Situate in Greenville County and State of S. Carolina lying between Horse Pen Creek and Guilder Creek being part of a Tract of Land granted to said Batte Birdsong in the date one thousand seven hundred and ninety one containing 12.62 acres the parcel of which this is sold to said Jones is as follows; beginning at a Post oak corner tree and running N. 78 E. 6. 2 to a stake thence on a line running N. 113 W. 38 E. 30 links to Guilder Creek, thence the various Course of P. Creek to a line running S. 61 E. 55 and along to a pine thence S. 30 W. 23 to a Pine thence S. 33 to a post oak thence a direct line to the beginning supposed to be three hundred acres be the same more or less on all Rivers waters Hereditaments Claims Rents Profits Tittes and Interest
