less Situated in Greenville County on the waters of Toulisburys
River it being part of a tract of Land which his Excellency William
Moistree Dugire and Grant unto Huston Clayton bearing date
the first day of July one thousand seven hundred and Ninety three and
Borrowed in grant book Q-1st page 346 which tract of containing 872 acres
