Edward Nelson of the State & County aforesaid the receipt

bargain, sell, alien, release convey & confirm unto the
said Edward Nelson, all that plantation tract or
parcel of Land containing two hundred & twenty acres
situate in Greenville County aforesaid on branches of
Cavendish Creek waters of South Sugar River bounded
by John Sparks and Madworth Matthew Sparks, William
Savages and Melly & William Boslands which said Land
was granted to the said said William Whaley on the 3rd day
of April in the year of our Lord 1797 reference being there
unto had well moufully appear. To have and to hold the
