Goodman being proven before Rubin Barrett Esq^r by the oaths
John Brunk was presented and Proven this 23rd day of April 1799
The State of S^t Carolina; Nowall man by these presents
That we John Standford & Martha Standford his wife of Green-
ville County and State aforesaid in Consideration of the
sum of Five Hundred Dollars to us in hand paid by Overton
Goodman of the County aforesaid we Granted Bargained sold
and Released & by these presents do Grant Bargain sell and
Release unto the S^t Overton Goodman a plantation
or tract of land lying and being in Greenville County of the
Sug River joining land late of to Henry Prince the same
being half of a tract of land Granted to Archable Dill the
first day of January in the year one thousand seven hundred
and eighty five and by Archable Dill Released to John Russel
deceased & by Burn Russel & Silvy Russel to Johnston Ford
Released Beginning on a Red oak corner on prairie line running
N^o 86 W. 55 chain to a Branch Red oak there N^o 60 E.
