



The Indenture made the 30th day of May one thousand seven
hundred and Ninety one and in the fifteenth year of the Indepen-
dence of America between Wm S Rodgers of Laurence County and

Witnesseth that the said Wm S Rodgers doth for and in Con-
sideration of the sum of six and Sixty pounds Sterling
money to him lawfull & truly paid by the said Luke
Cumpson the receipt whereof he the said Wm S Rodgers doth
acknowledege and hath Bargain'd sold and by these presents doth
give grant Bargain & sell & deliver unto him the said Luke Cumpson
his heirs and assigns forever one certain plantation or
tract of land containing three hundred and Sixty acres more or less
being granted to the said Wm S Rodgers by his Excellency Charles
Pinckney Governor & Commander in Chief in the said state and
bearing date September 6th 1799 and Recorded in Surveyners office
in Grant Book C. N^o 5 page 40 and Examined &c. Situated by
