 Granville County and State of said Grand Inconsistency
 of the sum of Two thousand one hundred and forty Three dollars
 to me paid by William Hunt of the State and County of said

Have Granted Bargained, sold and Released and by these presents do
 Grant Bargain sell and Release unto the said William Hunt
 plantation tract or parcel of Land containing seven hundred and
 forty four acres in the same more less Situate in Granville County
 of said on the North side of Saluda River being part of a tract
 of five hundred and ninety five acres of Land Granted to me
 the sixteenth day of July one thousand seven hundred and eighty
 four, Beginning on a Row Elm on the north side of Saluda
 River Running thence North fifteen degrees East to the place
 where Row wood's line crossing line thence with said Row
 wood's line North fifty five degrees West to Row wood's stake
