lle & State aforesaid on Senners Creek S^E 10^E to a pine
boiling lands of John Gorden. Containing by Estima-
tion Forty Two acres be the same more or less Granted
by patent bearing date 5th day of January 1789 to me
Beginning at a white oak running thence S^E 30^E N¹⁴ ch.
so thence to a stake thence S^E 53^E N⁴⁶ ch. 30 links to a
apple thence S^E 61^E N¹⁵ ch. 50 links to a chestnut thence
