for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty pounds to him  
in hand paid by the S. Ely Norman at and before the in  
sealing and delivering of these presents the Receipt and  
payment whereof is here by acknowledged he the said  
Isaac Norman hath Bargained and sold and by these  
presents doth Bargain and sell unto the said Ely Norman  
A plantation or tract of Land containing one hundred  
acres lying and being in Greenville County on the  
waters of Bush Creek Beginning on a Red oak and  
Running thence to N 20 E 27 to post oak thence N 70 W  
50 to Stake thence S 30 to Sasajras from thence to the  
beginning corner which said tract of Land containing  
one hundred acres with all and every of its appurtenances  
the said Isaac Norman doth from himself and his  
heirs and from all and every person and persons will  
warrant and forever defend to the S. Ely Norman his  
heirs and assigns forever in Witness whereof the said Isaac  
Norman hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal

by the S. Ely Norman at and before the In sealing and  
delivering of these presents the Receipt and payment where  
of is here by acknowledged he the S. Henry Norman hath  
bargained and sold and by these presents doth Bargain  
and sell unto the said Ely Norman a plantation or  
tract of Land fifty four acres lying and being in Greenville  
County on the waters of Brush Creek Beginning on a Red  
oak and Running N 30 W 31 to a Red oak thence S 50 W 36 to  
a stake thence N 10 E 15 to a post oak thence N 53 E  
37 to a Red oak thence S 44 E 21 to a post oak thence  
to the beginning corner which said tract of Land contain-  
ing fifty four acres with all and every of its appurtenan-  
ces the said Henry Norman doth from him self and his  
heirs and from all and every person and persons will war-  
rant and forever defend to the said Ely Norman his heirs  
and assigns forever in witness whereof the said Henry  
Norman hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his
