Know all men by these presents that I George Elliott of the  
County and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the  
sum of forty Dollars to me in hand paid by John Peden  
of the same place the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
do have granted bargain sold released & confirmed & by  
these presents do grant bargain sell release & confirm  
unto the said John Peden a parcel or tract of Land contain-  
ing twenty five acres more or less being originally granted  
to James Floyd situate lying and being in Greenville  
County on the waters of Red River beginning on a light  
wood stake & running thence to a post oak corner thence  
to a red oak corner at the head of a branch on the said James  
Floyds line thence S<sup>o</sup> to a pine corner on Millings line  
thence along Millings line to the beginning being the  
tract on which the said Elliott has and now lives on  
together with all and singular the rights members  
hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belong-  
ing in any wise incident or appertaining to have and  
to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned  
unto the said John Peden his heirs and assigns forever  
and I do here by bind my self my heirs Executors and  
administrators to warrant and forever defend all and  
singular the said premises unto the said John Peden his

every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the  
same or any part of the same in witness whereof I have set my hand  
and seal the twenty third of January one thousand seven  
hundred and ninety nine, and in the second year

The following deed of conveyance from Peter Sarter to Charles  
Waddle being proven before David Goodlett Esq. by the  
oath of Alex Waddle was presented and recorded this 27<sup>th</sup> day of April 1799  
This Indenture made this day of December in the year of our  
Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven and twenty  
second year of a merican Independence, Between Peter Sarter  
of Greenville County South Carolina of the one part and  
Charles Waddle sen<sup>r</sup> of the County & State aforesaid of the  
other part Now this Indenture witnesseth that the  
said Peter Sarter for and in consideration of the sum  
of one Hundred pound Sterling to him in hand paid  
by the said Charles Waddle hath Bargained & sold  
unto the said Waddle a certain plantation or tract  
of Land containing two Hundred acres be the same  
more or less it being part of a tract originally granted  
to John Thomas Jun<sup>r</sup> Now in the actual possession of  
of the said Charles Waddle sen<sup>r</sup> and was conveyed unto  
said Peter Sarter by said Thomas, & now by said Sarter  
unto said Waddle bounded east & South by land laid  
out for Mabel Johnston & on all other sides by vacant  
land whereon and recorded in Grant Book III page 539  
in the secretaries Office at Columbia and hath such  
Shapes & forms as may appear by a plat to the same
