That indenture made this 7th day of November in the year
of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty nine
and in the Independence of America the fourteenth
year Between Isaac James of Greenville County
and State of South Carolina of the one part and James
Clardy of Laurens County and State aforesaid of
the other part witnesseth that the aforesd Isaac
James and Dorothy his wife hath for and in considera-
tion of the full and just sum of Sixty pounds stan-
ding money to them in hand paid by the said James
Clardy the receipt whereof they the Isaac James &
Dorothy his wife hath acknowledged and hath bargain
and by these presents doth give grant Bargain
sell and deliver unto the aforesd James Clardy and
his wife heirs and assigns forever in fee simple one certain
tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in
the County of Greenville and State aforesd one branch
of Mountain Creek called the beaver dam the waters
of Saluda River containing two hundred acres it being
a tract of land granted to said Isaac James in the year
1787 and is bounded as follows Viz Beginning at a
corner Stake on Joel Chandlers line then west
along the same to a corner Head oak in Rickard Beams
line then south along the same to a corner stone
then south East along the same to a corner
corner Black Oak on John Shores North East along
the same to a corner Stake on Charles Swallowe's line
thence North to the beginning and hath such other
shape form and marks as a plat to the original Grant

hath hereto set their hands and seals the day and
year above written affixed sealed and delivered in pres-
