




Shew all men by these presents that John Champion of the County & State aforesaid has granted Bargained sold & Release & by these presents do Grant Bargain sell & Release unto John Duncan the tract of Land whereon the said Champion now lives containing two hundred & ninety acres originally granted unto James McEoy

227 By his Excellency William Moultrie Bearing Date the 5th day of June 1786 & Recorded in Grant Book 188th Conveyed from M. Eloy to Brock from Brock to Ragland & from Ragland to the afore mentioned Champion & hath such points & marks as the plat Represents also one other tract containing twenty acres more or less & bounded as follows Beginning at a state corner of the above mentioned Land running thence nearly a south course to a Hickory corner thence a west course to a black oak thence to the upper corner of said Land also twenty acres more or less to ten of the said that Champion purchased of the Langston Beginning on a Hickory corner of Brock Land & running nearly an East course to a Hickory in Solomon West Line & the said John Champion his & H^{is} D^oth Covenant & agree with the said John Duncan his Heirs & C that he shall hereafter peaceably & quietly hold occupy Possess & Enjoy the above Described premises unto the said John Duncan his Heirs & assigns forever from all Bargains sales mortgages judgments titles & Dowers & from all & every Person or persons claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof & the said John Champion his Heirs & C will warrant & forever defend the above mentioned premises unto the said John Duncan & his Heirs in Witness where of I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 1st day of January 1799 Signed sealed and Delivered in presence of ^{his} _{mark}  Thomas Edwards & Hugh McVey ^{his} _{mark}
