Know all men by these presents that Richard Brasill of Granville County in consideration of the sum of one hundred & thirty pounds to me paid by Nathaniel Gentry of the County aforesaid have Granted Bargained sold and Released and by these presents do Grant Bargain sell and Release unto the said Nathaniel Gentry a plantation or tract of Land in the County aforesaid of Queens Creek of S^c parolate River Beginning at an aqued corner between me & David Ball a Red Oak near a branch thence N. 78. 10 to a post Oak thence S. 50. W. 15. to post Oak thence S. 15 to a white oak thence E. 2. 2 to a Red Oak thence down a branch to the Creek thence up a branch North to the beginning containing Fifty Acres be the same more or less; being granted by a patent bearing date 5th June 1786 unto William Lynch and by him conveyed to me (whom I now live). Also one other Tract or parcel of Land adjoining the above beginning at a locked Ches^{nut} near a branch and running thence N. 60 E. 2. 6 Chain to a white oak thence N. 13. 1/2 to a post oak thence S. 50. E. 15. 1/2 to a post oak thence E. 1/2 Chain to a pine thence S. 2. 2. 1/2 to a stake thence S. 2. 5. 1/2 to a large poplar thence S. 10. W. 5. 1/2 to a stake thence to the Beginning

279 Containing by Estimation Three Hundred and forty Three Acres be the same more or less the same being Granted by patent bearing date July 11th 1793. Also one other Tract or parcel of Land lying in the County aforesaid on both sides of S^c parolate River Beginning at a Red Oak in the fork of the River & Queens Creek about a mile from the River Willy S Browns Corner running thence S. 2. 2. 1/2 of the river to a post Oak thence to a pine on David Halls Land thence N. 10. W. 11 Chain 50 Links to a pine thence N. 60 W. 7. 1/2 to a Chesnut Oak thence S. 10. 10. 1/2 to a Red Oak thence N. 60 E. to Willy S Browns line to a stake thence S. 39 E. to Red Oak thence S. 2. 2. E. 15. 1/2 to a Black thence S. 39 E. to the Beginning containing by Estimation One Hundred and six be the same more or less being part of a tract Granted by patent bearing date December 5th 1791 to Joseph Maxwell by him conveyed to John Huddleston & by him conveyed to William Saughlin & John his son & by them conveyed unto Adam Burkes & by him to me reference being had to the several conveyances will make this title more fully appear (there being Excepted at a shoal on the river a Sub Mill together with all singular the rights members hereditaments & appertinances to the said premises belonging or in anywise appertaining to have & to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Nathaniel Gentry his heirs & assigns forever & I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & Administrators to warrant & forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Nathaniel Gentry his heirs & assigns against myself & my heirs & against every person whomsoever Lawfully claiming a claim the same or any part thereof In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this Fifteenth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and
