This indenture made this 18th day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety Eight Between John Stensell of the State of South Carolina of the one part and Samuel Stensell of Greenville County and State of South Carolina of the other part Witnesses that for and in consideration of the sum of twenty five pounds sterling to him in hand paid by the said Samuel Stensell before the sealing and delivering of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth Grant Bargain and sell a linn Release Convey and Convey unto Samuel Stensell his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever an certain tract or parcel of Land Situate and lying and being on both sides of Bartons Creek the North fork of Sygar River Middle Indian Path having such shapes and courses as follows Beginning at a mark on a gang Running down the Branch to the Creek thence from the Creek up the other Branch to the out side line Next to the Mountain thence following the line round to the branch that is towards Thomas Bartons containing seven ty four Acres more or less together with all woods waters Rights Spurs profits Appurtenances thereunto belonging with every part and parcel and parcel unto the said

Know all men by these presents that I Thomas Butler of Edgefield County in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of seven teen pounds to me paid by Jonathan Davis Greenville County and State aforesaid have granted bargained sold & released & by these presents do Grant bargain & sell unto the said Jonathan Davis part of a part of Land originally granted to Thomas Jan Senr Bearing date the eighth day of July 1774 and recorded in Grant Book 182 page 113 Joining the said Davis Land & that such shape & form as may appear by a plat to the same containing one hundred and pretty acres be the same more or less Together with the rights members and appurtenances to the said premises thereunto belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining to have & to hold unto the said Jonathan Davis his heirs & assigns forever & do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Jonathan Davis his heirs & assigns against me and my heirs and all other persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof In witness whereof I seal this 13th day of Feb^r 1799 and in the twenty second year of our said Sovereigns Kings of Great Britain present King William the Third William Jones
