Know all men by these presents that I Andrew Nelson of the County & State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of one Hundred & fifty Dollars to me in hand paid B. Andrew McDavid of the same County & State aforesaid have granted Bargained & sold and released & by these presents doth grant Bargain Sell and Release unto the said Andrew McDavid all that plantation or tract of Land it being and lying on the North side of Rudy River and in the County of Greenville containing one Hundred and more or less Beginning on a person on said River running East to a conditional post Oak corner on the old line from thence a S^o course & corner to a post Oak on the old line thence a west course on the old line to the River thence up said River to the beginning corner the mile seat & and yard in blade with said Land on the South side of said River with all and singular the rights members Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises Belonging or in any wise incident to the said premises to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Andrew McDavid his Heirs and assigns forever and I do here by being myself my Heirs Executors and Administrators & assigns to warrant & forever defend all and singular the premises unto the said Andrew McDavid his Heirs and assigns against myself my Heirs in and every person whatsoever lawfully claiming the same in witness hereof I have hereunto

Smith Black Smith of said State and County of Greenville to be granted Bargained sold & released and by these presents doth grant bargain sell & Release unto said W^m Smith all that tract of Land containing four Hundred acres more or less adjoining Lands now Belonging to D^r Hudson on the north side N.E. on George Scalens William Wilsons of the South Widow Maxwell on the S^W Reelin S^c rents on the N^o lying and lying in said State and County of Greenville on Grove Creek Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise appertaining or incident I have and to hold all and singular the premises be fore mentioned unto the said W^m Smith his Heirs and assigns forever And I do here by being myself my Heirs Executors & Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said William Smith his Heirs and assigns and against myself and my Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof

The following deed of conveyance from Thomas Brummit to John Covenhoven being proven before William Reed Esq. by the oath of William Bly was presented and recorded this 24th day of July 1799

This Indenture made this 24th day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety four between Thomas Brummit of the County of Greenville of the one part & John Covenhoven of the same County aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the Thomas Brummit for and in consideration of the sum of thirty pounds to him in hand paid by the said John Covenhoven at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt of which the said Thomas doth here by acknowledge & then with to be fully satisfied contented & paid hath granted Bargained & sold & by these presents doth Grant Bargain & sell unto the said John Covenhoven & his Heirs all that plantation or or tract of two hundred & seven acres of Land whereon Covenhoven now Lives Originally Granted unto the said Thomas Brummit as well appear by a grant bearing date the 3rd day February 1784 & in the hand & seal of his Excellency William Moultrie Esq. Governor
