






Know all men by these presents that I Charles Estes of Greenville County in the State aforesaid in consideration of Two hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Edward Lee of the County State and County aforesaid have Granted Bargained, sold and Released and by these presents do Grant Bargain, sell, and Release unto the said Edward Lee a plantation or tract of Land containing two hundred acres (Be the same more or less) Situate in Greenville County lying on Little horse Creek. Beginning on a dogwood st running thence N 21 E 1/2 50th on Benjamin Townsens line to a Red Oak st thence N 65 W 21st to a Red Oak st on Thompsons Bristers line thence S 5 W 17th 30th on said line to a Red Oak st thence N 85 W 75th 50th on said Bristers line to a stake st thence S. 61 E. 95th on William Cohens line to the Beginning (being part of a tract of eight hundred and forty two acres of Land Originally Granted to William Wood on the first day of May 1786) Together with all and singular the Rights & Members hereunto and appertaining to the said premises belonging in any wise Incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises Before mentioned unto the said Edward Lee his heirs and assigns forever. And I do here by Bind my self, my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever Defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Edward Lee his heirs and assigns against my self & my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof

Know all men by these presents that I Charles Estes of Greenville County in the State aforesaid in consideration of Two hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by William Coke of the County and State aforesaid have Granted Bargained sold and released and by these presents do Grant Bargain, sell and Release unto the said William Coke a Plantation or tract of Land containing Three hundred and seventy five acres (Be the same more or less) Situate in Greenville County lying on Little horse Creek Water of Rocky River Beginning on a dogwood st running thence S. 21 W. 68th to a red Oak st thence W 56th 25th 50th to a Stake st thence N 21 W 57th on Abigail Estes line to a Stake st thence N 5 W 11th 40th on Charles Estes line to P. O. st thence S. 60 E. 41st 75th on said Estes line to a Stake st thence S. 61 E. 46th on Edward Lees line to the Beginning Being part of a tract of eight hundred and forty two acres of Land, Originally Granted to William Wood on the first day of May 1786

Together with all and singular the Rights and members hereunto and appertaining to the said premises belonging in any wise Incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Coke his heirs and assigns forever. And I do here by Bind my self, my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said William Coke his heirs & assigns against my self and my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
