



The following deed of Conveyance from Samuel Kistell to Adlie

James Gilbert one hundred acres of Land it being a part of a certain
Tract Granted unto Richard Folger tract situate in state and
County aforesaid on Darbin Creek waters of Broad River Granted unto
him the 5th Fowler the Twenty third of July in the Year 1774
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
