343 The following deed of Conveyance from Archable Fowler to Sepe Suggs
being proven before David Goodlett Esq^r by the oath of William Rodgers was
presented and recorded this 10th day of September 1799

This instrument made the 5th day of January One thousand seven
hundred and ninety eight and of the Independence of the United States
of America the Twenty Third between Archable Fowler of the State
of Carolina and County of Greenville of the one part & Sepe Suggs
of the County and State afores^d of the other part witnesseth & concurring
consideration of the sum of Thirty Pounds Sterling law full money of the state
is here paid by Sepe Suggs hath bargained and sold & by these presents
doth bargain sell and make convey to the s^rd Sepe Suggs a certain plantation
on Tract of Land lying in Greenville County on the Head branches
of Richland Creek of Rudy River which Sepe Suggs now lies on and hath
such boundary wherein as it begins on a Black Oak corner running
thence N. 40° E. 13 C. to a Spanish Oak corner thence west 40° 50' to a
state corner thence S. 75° W. 15 C. to a post Oak corner thence N. 72° W. 18 C.
to a Black Oak corner thence S. 5° W. 13 to Elm corner thence N. 72° W.
10 C. to a state corner thence S. 65° W. to a conditional Black Oak
corner thence to a conditional Black Oak corner on Gladswell line
thence S. 66 C. to a Post Oak corner thence S. 70 C. 25 to state corner from
thence to the beginning it being a part of a tract of Land containing eight
hundred and forty acres granted unto Archable Fowler from under the

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hand of his Excellency William Moultrie Esq^r bearing date the fourth

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The following deed of Conveyance from Edward Smith to Jacob Cooley being
proven before Humphrey Cobb Esq^r by the oath of Samuel Roberts was
presented and recorded this 10th day of September 1799

This instrument made this Twenty fifth day of November
One thousand seven hundred and ninety five and in the nineteenth
year of the Independence of the United States of America between
Edward Smith of Pendleton County and State of Carolina of the
one part and Jacob Cooley of the County of Greenville & State aforesaid
of the other part witnesseth that the said Edward Smith for and in
consideration of the sum of One hundred pounds Sterling money to me
in hand paid at & before the sealing and delivering of these presents the
