in consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars to me p^d
by Joseph Benson of the District and State aforesaid have
Granted Bargained sold and Released and by these presents do
Grant Bargain and Release unto Joseph Benson all that
tract or parcel of Land containing one hundred and Two acres
being part of a tract of Land granted Humphrey Sroggins
by his Excellency Benjamin Guverand Governor of the State of S^c
Carolina and dated the 15th day of October one thousand seven
hundred and Eighty four beginning at a white Oak Bensons
corner thence N 46 Chain to a spanish Oak thence west 30 chain
to Stake thence S 15 E 42 Chain to Red Oak thence S 45 E 23
Chain to a Crabapple tree Thompsons line thence N 44 E 7
Chain to the beginning the above mentioned land lying and
being on the waters of the Golden grove Creek to gether with

day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred


