Know all men by these presents that I George Tankerly of the State and District aforesaid for the consideration of the sum of Fifty Dollars to me in hand paid by Jeremiah Smith of the state & District aforesaid have granted bargained sold and Release unto Jeremiah Smith part of a tract of Land Originally Granted to Humphrey Scroggins by his Excellency Benjamin Gualford Governor of the state of Carolina at dated the 15th day of October 1784 the abovementioned land lying and being on the waters of the Golden Grove Creek bounded by Joseph Binsons, Waddy Thompsons and William Binsons land containing 15 acres more or less and I the said George Tankerly do warrant and forever defend the above mentioned land to Jeremiah Smith and his Heirs free and clear from me and my Heirs and from all and every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 11th day of May 1800

I know yet that I Gershon Kelley of Greenville County in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the very Great love and affection that I bear unto my beloved Daughter Anne Daunting, of the County and State aforesaid and for an consideration of the sum of ten Shillings Sterling

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of and delivering of these presents the Receipt whereof I do here by acknowledge, and my self there with fully satisfy'd and paid and for other good causes and considerations me then and now moving have given grant'd and confirm'd unto the said Anne Daunting, Heirs of her body lawfully begotten forever, as fully, freely, and absolutely give Grant and Confirm, unto the Heirs of my said daughter one negrowoman named Phillas, and her daughter named Charlotte, and there further I give to have and to hold the said negroes Phillas and her Daughter Charlotte unto the said Heirs of my Daughter lawfully begotten, left to care of Robert and Anne Daunting these natural life time, and I the said Gershon Kelley for my self my Executors administrators and assigns forever shall and warrant and defend by these presents In witness whereof I the said Gershon Kelley have set my hand and seal this thirty first day of August in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and ninety nine in the twenty fourth year of my age. The following Deed of Conveyance from William Standford to Pleasant Esley being proven before David Goodlett Esq. by the oath of him Esley was presented and Recorded this 14th day of May 1800
This Indenture made this Twentieth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and in the ~~one~~^{forty} year of the sovereignty and In the presence of the united States of America between William Standford of the state of S Carolina and Greenville District of the one part & Pleasant Esley of the same State and District aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the said William
