This Indenture made this Twenty second day of January in the year of our Lord Christ Eighteen Hundred Between Samuel Magness of Greenville County and State of S^c Carolina of the one part and William Duncan of the same County & State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the said Samuel Magness for and in Consideration of the sum of Two Hundred dollars to him in Hand paid by the said Duncan before the Sealing & Delivery of these presents doth hereby acknowledge Hath Granted Bargained & sold by these presents unto Grant Bargain & sell unto the said Duncan His Heirs & assigns forever one certain Tract or parcel of Land Situate lying and being in the County aforesaid on the waters of Ready River Containing one hundred and eighteen acres more or less and bounded as follows Viz Beginning at old pine stump on Sammons line thence S^o ward a conditional line to a post oak marked by the parties on the old original line west to a hickory corner thence the original S^o to a red oak corner thence E to the beginning To have and to hold the above sold land & premises with all and singular the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging or any ways appertaining unto him the said William Duncan his Heirs & assigns forever to the only proprieuse & behoof of him the said William Duncan his Heirs and assigns forever to have hold use occupy possess & enjoy the same with every part or parcel thereof unto him the said William Duncan his Heirs and assigns forever against him the said Samuel Magness or his Heirs and against the law men
