Francis Robertson, Mary Mosley, Lucretia Finny, Catharine Sauer Degraffin-
nid, & Nancy N. Ham Degraffinnid being proven before David Goddett
Esq. by the oath of Thomas Lorton was presented and Recorded this
5th day of June 1800

Now all men by these Presents that Lucretia Degraffinnid of
the District of Greenville and State of S. Carolina For and in
consideration of the Natural Love and Affection which I bear to
Wm Robertson, Francis Robertson, Mary Mosley, Lucretia Finny,
Catharine Sauer Degraffinnid & Nancy N. Degraffinnid of the
above named District and State, as well as for the further consi-
deration of one Dollar to me in hand paid by each of the above
named persons at or before sealing and Delivering of these presents
the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have given and Granted
and by these presents do give and grant unto the said William
Robertson, Francis Robertson, Mary Mosley, Lucretia Degraffin-
nid, Catharine Sauer Degraffinnid, & Nancy N. Degraffinnid
their Executors administrators and assigns, in the following manner,

to wit To my son William Robertson five Negroes Jim, Fanny,
Lewis, Dexter and Jerry and all their Increase to him and his Heirs
forever. To my son Francis Robertson three Negroes Bratker, Harry
and George, But if my son Francis Robertson should die without
lawful Issue then the above named Harry to return to my Grand
son Francis Robertson son of William Robertson, and the above
named Bratker and George to my grand Daughter Lucretia
ann Mosley daughter of Harry Mosley, to them and their
Heirs forever. To my Daughter Mary Mosley three Negroes Julia, Sam,
and Jack, to her and her Heirs forever. To my Daughter Lucretia
Finny one negro girl named Cloe to her and her Heirs forever
To my Daughter Catharine Sauer one negro girl named Anara
