




22 The following Deed of Conveyance from Nathaniel Gentry to Jeremiah Brown being proven before Willy S Brown Esq^r by the oath of Joseph Cavin was presented and recorded this 13 day of June 1800 State of S Carolina Know all men by these presents that I Nathaniel Gentry of Greenville County in Consideration of the sum of two hundred and thirty Dollars to me paid by Jeremiah Brown of the County aforesaid have granted bargained sold and Released and and by these presents do Grant bargain sell and release unto the said Jeremiah Brown a plantation or tract of Land lying and

1129 being in the County aforesaid on both sides of S Catawba River Beginning at a Red Oak in the fork of the Greens Creek and the river about one chain from the River Willey S Browns corner running thence S 30 W crossing the River the river to a Post Oak thence to a Pine on David Halls land thence N 10 W 11 Ch 50 Lk^s to a pine thence N 60 W 7 Ch^s to a chestnut oak thence N 10 W 19 Ch^s crossing the river to a red oak thence N 60 E to Willey S Browns line to a stake thence S 30 E to a red oak thence S 28 E 15 Ch^s to a black Oak thence S 39 E to the beginning containing by Estimation One hundred acres be the same manner as being part of a tract granted by Patent to Joseph Apperwell bearing date 5 day of December 1791 and by him conveyed to John Huddleston and by him conveyed to William Laughlin son of John his son and by them conveyed to Sham Burke & by him conveyed to Richard Brasell and by him to me when on is erected a tub mill Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appertanances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Jeremiah Brown his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Jeremiah Brown his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever Lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this eighth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety nine and Twenty fourth year of American Independence
