proven before Iesse Carter by the oath of David Goodlett Esq^r was presented and
recorded this 18th day of July 1800

The State of S^t Carolina — Know all men by these presents that Andrew Vos of Charleston in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and seventy five Dollars to me paid by Jonathan Potts of Greenville District in the state aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Jonathan Potts all that plantation or tract of land lying and being in Greenville District on the middle fork of Saluda river Beginning at a Spanish Oak N^o 50 Wth 20 chains to a white oak stake there N^o 50 Wth 8 chain to a white oak corner there N^o 50 chain to a stake there N^o 68 Eth 87 chain to a stake there N^o 18 Eth 56 chain 80 links to the beginning and hath such shape and marks as may appear by a plat to the same originally surveyed for Ephraim Ellis and granted to Job Colcock the 3^d of April 1786 and by him conveyed to the said Andrew Vos by Deed of Sale and Release on the 27th April 1787 and now by this Deed to Andrew Vos to the said Jonathan Potts containing Three Hundred and Fifty acres be the same more or less together with all and singular the Rights, members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident to or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Jonathan Potts his Heirs and assigns myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof as witness my hand and seal this Twentieth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety nine and in the Twenty third year of America's Independence

The following Deed of Conveyance from Abner Norriss to John Stetton Sub^r being proven before Hugh Wiley Esq^r by the oath of James Brock was presented and recorded this 24th day of July 1800

The State of S^t Carolina — Know all men by these presents that Abner Norriss of the County of Greenville and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifteen dollars to me paid by John Stetton Sub^r of the State and County aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do bargain sell and release unto the said John Stetton Sub^r certain Tracts of Land situated on the middle fork of Saluda river Beginning on John Stetton Sub^r Line on river Running up the Creek to the Mouth of the Oil Camp Creek thence up the Creek to the said Sub^r to a white Oak on the Creek a conditional corner from thence a line to a dogwood corner on the old original line hence along the old line to the River to the beginning for compliment fifty acres more or less together with all and singular the Rights, members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident to or pertaining to have and to hold all and singular the granted premises as before mentioned unto the said John Stetton his heirs and assigns forever and do hereby bind myself my heirs and executors and administrators to warrant and for ever defend the same granted premises unto the said John Stetton his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and against executors and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof as witness my hand and seal this Twentieth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety nine and in the Twenty third year of America's Independence
