

456 The following Deed of Conveyance from Reubin Barrett to Runnels Dill being proven before Reubin Barrett Esq^r by the oath of David Jackson was presented and Recorded this 28th day of July 1800.

South Carolina — Know all men by these presents that I Reubin Barrett of Greenville District and State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of one hundred and ninety Dollars to me paid by Runnels Dill of said District have bargained sold and Released and by these presents do Grant bargain sell and Release unto the said Runnels Dill a Plantation or tract of Land lying and being in Greenville District on the waters of Parks Creek of South Sycan River Beginning on a Post Oak on the Side of Parks Mountain running N 61 E until it intersects Solomon Dills line Parts of the Original tracts of Land thence across the said land on Solomon Dills line agreed on by said Solomon and Runnels to their beginning Corner near a branch on Archable Dills line on a Red oak Saplin thence S 60 W on Archable Dills line to a Red oak thence S 30 E to the Beginning post oak Containing by Estimation one hundred and fifty acres more or less the Place whereon Archable Dill now lives the same being Parts of a tract of Land Granted to me by a Patent bearing date the fourth day of December in the

457 The Following Deed of Conveyance from Joseph Willis to William Thurston being proven before John Young Esq^r by the oath of Willis Thurston was presented and Recorded this 28th day of July 1800

The State of South Carolina — Know all men by these presents that we Joseph Willis and Mary Willis his wife of Greenville County in the State aforesaid Planter in consideration of Two hundred dollars to us in hand paid by William Thurston of the County and State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and Released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and Release unto the said William Thurston, all that Plantation or tracts of six hundred acres of Land be the same more or less situate in Greenville County on the waters of Reddy River, beginning on a Post oak on John Carles line running thence N 68 W with said line 30 50 to a Red oak on McClaughens line thence S 60 W with said line 48 50 links to a black gum near the Fork of a branch, thence up the left hand fork of s^d branch with the meanders to a second fork, thence up the middle fork of the
