Know all men by these presents that I Lemuel Lott of Greenville County in the said State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Fifty Dollars to him in hand paid by Edward Smith of the County aforesaid have Granted bargained and sold and released unto the said Edward Smith all that tract or Parcel of Land containing fifty acres or there more or less beginning at Clinch's line on a black Oak thence East fifty Poles to a Post Oak at the Old boundary thence north to a black oak thence thence west to a black gum on Smith's line all and singular the Rights and members
