to me paid by William Calloway of said County and  
State aforesaid have granted bargained & sold & released and  
by these presents do grant bargain and sell and release  
unto the said William Calloway a Plantation or  
tract of land lying and being in Greenville County  
on a Mash within the waters of Tygar & originally gran-  
ted to Esley Hunt on the fourth of April Eighty five  
and by him conveyed to Baylis Earle by lease and Release  
and with such Shape form and marks as may be seen  
by a plat to said Grant containing two hundred acres  
together with all and singular the Rights members  
requisites and appurtenances to the said premi-  
ses belonging or in any wise appertaining or incident  
there to (Except Fifty acres across the lower end of
