Jordan together with all and singular the Rights
Members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said
Premises belonging or in anywise incident or apper-
taining to have and to hold all and singular the Premises
unto the said Joseph Smith his
Heirs and assigns for ever and so here by bind myself my
heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant &
for ever defend all and singular the said Premises unto
the said Joseph Smith his heirs and assigns against my
self and my heirs and against every person whomsoever
lawfully claiming or to Claim the same or any part
there of - Witness My hand and seal this 18 day of
January 1800 and in the twenty fourth Year of the
Independence of the United States of America
