

The following Lease and Release from Abraham Markley
to Joseph Bridges being Proven before Robert Woffa
Esq by the Oath of James Tomms was Presented &
Recorded this 17th day of October 1800

This Indenture Made the nine-
teenth day of January in the year of Our Lord
One thousand seven hundred and ninety Two Between
Abraham Markley of Charleston State of South
Carolina Merchants of the One part and Joseph
Bridges of Greenville County ninety six District
State aforesaid of the Other Part Witnesseth
that the said Abraham Markley for and in con-
sideration of the sum of five shillings Sterling
Currant of said State to him in hand well and
Truly paid by the said Joseph Bridges and before
the sealing and delivery hereof (The receipt whereof
is here by Acknowledge, hath bargained and sold and
by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the
said Joseph Bridges Executor, administrators and assigns
a certain Plantation or tract of Land situate lying &
being in Greenville County North of Saluda River
of Old Boundary ninety six District and state aforesaid
Messuage and containing Two hundred and Eighteen
acres more or less Originally Granted to Thomas
Lehman Lying and being on the waters of Langston Creek
of Sucky River butting and bounding as is therein
then of annexed to the Grant Recorded in Grant
