Carolina, Know all men by these presents that I John Barnett of the State aforesaid and County of Greenville for and in consideration of one hundred dollars to me paid by James Harrison of said State and County have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said James Harrison all that tract or parcel of land whereon I now live lying and being in Greenville County on the waters of mountain, and Horse creek containing by estimation three hundred and thirty five acres more or less purchased by me from Atthe Meeks and conveyed to me by the said Atthe Meeks on the thirtieth day of Septem<sup>r</sup> 1797 reference therunto will fully appear. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said James Harrison his heirs and assigns for ever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said James Harrison his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, witness my hand and seal this fifteenth day of January one thousand seven hundred and ninety nine
