John Huggens doth hereby acknowledge have granted bargained sold aliened and conformed, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and confirm unto the said Archibald Mahan his heirs and assigns for ever part of a certain tract of land Originally granted to Robert Cravens the third day of April 1786 the whole grant containing 500 acres and the said John Huggins conveys one hundred acres more or less by the boundaries hereafter mentioned begining at a stake on Pendleton line thence S^t. 25° W 35 chain along Armstrongs line to William Brashears corner black oak, thence N^o. 48° W 43 chain along William Brashears line, to black oak thence N 45 East 40 chain by the widow Sowels land to Pendleton line Stake thence along Pendleton line to the begining, the above mentioned land on the golden groov creek callidgachary branch, Together with all and singular the houses out houses ways water hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said plantation or tract of land belonging or in any wise appertaining, and the reversion and reversioners rents issues and profits thereof to have and to hold the said plantation or tract of land containing one hundred acres more or less and all and singular other the premises above mentioned with the appurtenances unto the said
